Dear Illinois Medication Assistance Program (ADAP) Clinician:

The Illinois Department of Public Health would like to notify you of a change in the pharmacy service provider for members of the Illinois Department of Public Health's Medication Assistance Program (ADAP) who currently receive medication from CVS Specialty Pharmacy. **Effective December, 1, 2021** prescription services will be transitioned from CVS Pharmacy to Walgreens Pharmacy.

We know how important it is for your patients to remain adherent to their treatment, so the Department is taking steps to ensure that there is no disruption in a member's ability to receive their prescriptions. We request clinicians to work together with Walgreens to continue access to medications.

Please be advised of the prescription transfer process for this prescription service transition:

- All prescriptions with refills will be automatically transferred from CVS to Walgreens. There is no action required of the clinician for prescriptions with refills.
- Prescriptions with no refills or new prescriptions written after 12/1/2021 should be sent via electronic prescription to any one of the 21 Walgreens pharmacy locations listed below:

- ✓ Document delivery pick up location (e.g. patient's home or local Walgreens pharmacy)

Program members will now have the added option of picking up prescriptions at the pharmacy or if preferred, may continue receiving them in the mail as in the past. Program members are encouraged to let the Walgreens staff know if their preference is walk-in service or mail service.
